Dr. Miller received the degree of B.T.U. from Colgate University and the honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity from the same school. He is now Adjunct Professor of the Philosophy of Religion at Andover Newton Theological School and Lecturer in Pastoral Theology at the Harvard Divinity School. His literary works include: THE SIGN OF THE SOUL, PRAYERS IN THE DARK OF WAR, THE LIFE OF THE SOUL, AND THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH. In the Summer of 1955, his new book THE GREAT REALITIES was published by Harpers.

Dr. Weatherspoon received the A.B. and M.A. degrees from Wake Forest College; the Th.M. and Th.D. from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and the D.D. from Wake Forest College. Professor in the Department of Preaching, Southern Seminary. He is the author of THE BOOK WE TEACH, ON THE PREPARATION AND DELIVERY OF SERMONS (Revisions), THE OBJECTIVES OF PREACHING, APOSTOLIC PREACHING, SENT FORTH TO PREACH. He is a native of Durham, N. C. and a former pastor of the First Baptist Church, Winston-Salem, N. C.
