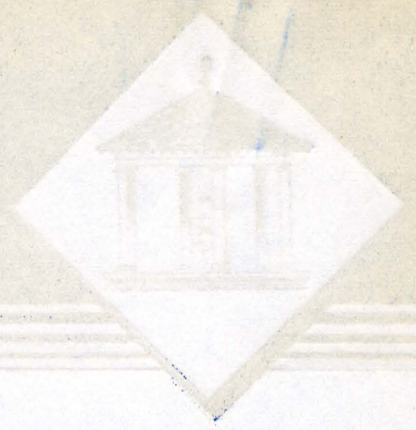
FIRST SEMINARY SOCIAL
