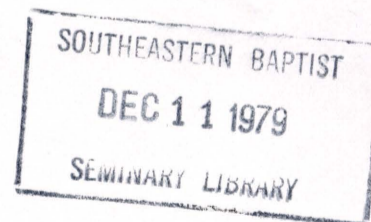
SBC SEMINARY PRESIDENTS' WORKSHOP
