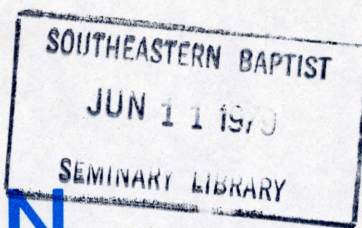

SUMMER RECREATION:

During the summer school session, recreation opportunities will be available through the use of the recreation room, tennis courts and the gymnasium. The recreation room in Mackie Hall is equipped with ping pong tables and a pool table and will be open Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Supervised hours for the tennis courts will begin at approximately 2:30 p.m. Monday - Friday. The courts open at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday. For use during other hours, keys may be checked out by students or staff for two hours. The gym will be available for use Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Keys may be checked out by students or staff for two hours. I.D.'s are required for all keys which can be checked out from the Student Affairs Office, second floor, Mackie Hall.

MMPI DATES:

All new, entering students are required to take the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory in order to fulfill matriculation requirements. The MMPI will be administered on Thursday, June 21 at two separate times, 1:05 and 3:15 p.m. in the second floor conference room, Mackie Hall. The inventory takes approximate one and a half hours to complete and students may take it at the session most convenient for their schedules. Questions concerning the MMPI may be directed to Mr. Catoe in the Student Affairs Office.
