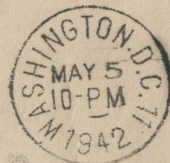

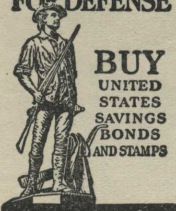
Your patriotic cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
