- 5th. Appointed the next session of this body with Shiloah Church, Bibb County, Georgia, usual time, four miles from Lizella, on M. & B. R., near same distance from Macon west.
- 6th, Appointed Union meeting with Sardis Church, Bibb County, embracing 5th Sabbath in May, 1892.
- 7th. Called for corresponding letter. The same read and adopted.
- 8th. Called for contributions from the churches, and received \$22.50 for minutes.
 - 9th. Agreed to have 1,000 copies of this minute printed.
- 10th. Returned correspondence to the Flint River Union to convene with Bluff Springs Church, five miles from Andersonville, commencing on Friday before the 1st Sunday in Sept. 1892. B. T. Collier, W. H. Smith, J. M. Fredrick, H. J. Brown, T. J. Nelson, J. B. Hunt, Wiley Green, R. E. Story, J. M. Pitts, J. T. Young, J. W. Hering and M. F. Etheridge.
