

# MINUTES.

FRIDAY, 11 O'CLOCK, SEPT. 13TH. A. M.

4th. Appointed Union Meeting with Fellowship church Houston Co., embracing the 5th Sunday in March, 1902.

5th. Appointed next session of the body with Pilgrims' Rest church, Houston County, 3 miles South East of Echeconnee crossing S. W. R. R., our usual time.

6th. Called for corresponding letter, read and adopted.

7th. Called for Contributions and received \$10.00 for Minutes and agreed to have 500 printed.

8th. Adjourned to time and place above mentioned.
