RAPID READING CLASS: A class in Rapid Reading will be offered on the campus beginning on Tuesday, September 30. The class will be taught by Dr. Carroll Trotter, and will meet on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 4:00 until 6:00 o'clock, through Thursday, November 6. No classes will be held during the week of October 20. A fee of \$3.00 is charged, and the class is open to all students and students' wives.
