



## John Westerhoff

John Westerhoff, an Episcopal priest, has taught at Duke University since 1973 and is presently professor of Religion and Education and chairperson of the Ministerial Studies Division in the Divinity School. He holds degrees from Ursinus College, Harvard University Divinity School, Union Theological Seminary and Columbia University Teachers College in the fields of theology, anthropology and educational foundations. He is married and has three children.

Dr. Westerhoff was the founder-editor of *Colloquy*, a national, ecumenical magazine on education in church and society. He is also the editor of *Religious Education*, an international, ecumenical, professional journal. He is an officer in the Association of Professors and Researchers in Religious Education, a director of the Religious Educators Association, and a faculty associate of the Baldwin Federation at Duke University.

Author of numerous articles and book chapters, he has written twelve books: Values for Tomorrow's Children, A Colloquy on Christian Education, Generation to Generation, Tomorrow's Church, McGuffey and His Readers, Learning Through Liturgy, The Church's Ministry in Higher Education, Inner Growth and Outer Change, Will Our Children Have Faith?, Christian Believing, Bringing Up Children in the Christian Faith, and Liturgy and Learning Through the Life Cycle.
