FELLOWSHIP ASSOCIATION

*Minutes of the Fellowship Primitive Baptist Association
held with Woodland Church, Woodland, Georgia,
September 17th, 18th and 19th, 1918.*

1st. The Introductory Sermon was preached by Elder S. H. Whatley, of the Itchaconnee Association.

2nd. Called for, received and read letters from the churches, and entered messengers names.

3rd. Invited visiting brethren and sisters to seats with us.

4th. Appointed committees as follows:

(a) On Preaching—G. R. Lowe, L. Cobb, B. C. Smith, J. B. Griffin and C. G. Adams.

(b) On Finance—A. J. Taylor, S. L. Fleming, and A. J. Laney.

5th. Agreed to hold the next session of this body with Ramah Church, at Buena Vista, Georgia, Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday after the third Sunday in September, 1919.

6th. Agreed to have 500 minutes printed for distribution among the churches.

7th. RESOLVED. That we tender our sincere thanks and appreciation to the people of Woodland and community for their courtesies and kind hospitality shown us while in their midst; and that we pray the blessings of heaven upon them and their homes.

8th. Read minutes and adjourned.

MINUTES

Articles of Faith

1. We believe in one true and living God, and that there are three persons in the Godhead, viz.: The Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

2. We believe in the fall of man and his inability to recover himself.

3. We believe Jesus Christ to be the son of God.—
I Tim. ii 5.

4. We believe in particular election; effectual calling of the elect, and final preservation of the saints.

5. We believe the Scripture of the Old and New Testaments to be the word of God.

6. We believe that Baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of Jesus Christ, and the washing of the saint's feet an example, and that no man has the right to administer the ordinance of Baptism and the Lord's Supper but such as are regularly called and come under the imposition of hands by the presbytery.

7. We believe that immersion is the scriptural mode of baptism.

8. We believe in a final judgement, in a future state of reward and punishment, and that of eternal duration.
