Proceedings of the Ninety-Sixth Annual Meeting of the

Elk River Association

Of Primitive Baptists

Held with the Church at Wagner's Creek, Franklin County, Tenn., Beginning on Friday Before the Second Sunday in September, 1903, and two days Following

The introductory sermon was delivered by Elder J. E. Frost. Subject—"Sufficiency of the Spirit's Teaching." Text St. John 15:26. "But when the Comforter is come whom I will send unto you from the Father, the spirit of truth," etc.

After which the Messengers from the churches met and were called to order by the Moderator. Singing; prayer by Elder J. B. White. The letters from the churches read and Messengers invited to seats. The letters show the state of the churches as exhibited in the table.

The Association organized by choosing Elder J. E. Frost Moderator and W. A. Cashion Clerk.

The Association then proceeded to business as follows:

On motion the Association elected the following Elders to preach at the stand Sunday: L. M. Gorden, Lytle Burns and A. J. Willis, who came forth and preached in order of these names, to the honor and glory of God and to the comfort of God's children.

On motion the Association extended their thanks to brethren, sisters and friends of this community for their kind hospitality during the meeting of the Association.

On motion the Minutes read and approved.

On motion the Association adjourned to meet at the time and place mentioned in the Minutes.
