

MINUTES

1. Introductory sermon preached by Elder W. W. Childs, of Yatesville, Ga.

2. Called for, received and read the letters from the churches, and enrolled the messengers names.

3. Invited visiting brethren and sisters to seats with us.

4. Appointed committees as follows:

(a) On preaching—brethren A. J. Taylor, J. C. Pye, W. M. Laney, W. P. McCorkle and Elder W. W. Riner.

(b) On finance—brethren Geo. R. Lowe, J. Arthur Moore and A. J. Laney.

5. Agreed to hold the next session of this body with Fellowship Church, Shiloh, Ga., on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, after the third Sunday in September, 1921.

6. Received messengers and a letter from Providence Church near Tallassee, Ala., asking admission into the Association which was granted.

7. Agreed to have 500 copies of minutes printed for distribution among the churches.

ARTICLES OF FAITH

1. We believe in one true and living God, and that there are three persons in the Godhead, viz: The Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

2. We believe in the fall of man and his inability to recover himself.

3. We believe Jesus Christ to be the son of God.—
1 Tim. ii 5.

4. We believe in particular election, effectual calling of the elect, and final preservation of the saints.

5. We believe the Scripture of the old and new Testaments to be the word of God.

6. We believe that Baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of Jesus Christ, and the washing of the saint's feet an example, and that no man has the right to administer the ordinance of Baptism and the Lord's Supper but such as are regularly called and come under the imposition of hands by the presbytery.

7. We believe that immersion is the scriptural mode of baptism.

8. We believe in a final judgment, in a future state of reward and punishment, and that of eternal duration.
