MINUTES.

FRIDAY, SEPT. 14TH, 1900, 11 o'CLOCK A. M.

1st. The introductory sermon was delivered by Elder S. J. English of the Flint River Corresponding Association.

2nd. After one hours' intermission the messengers assembled in the House; prayer by Elder English.

3rd. Read letters from the churches, and enrolled names of messengers.

4th. Re-elected Elder J. W. Herin Moderator, and M. F. Etheridge Clerk.

5th. Appointed the following committee on Preaching: L. A. Stubbs, W. G. Middlebrooks, W. E. Green, J. H. Colquit and M. J. Ray. On Business to come before body: J. R. Roberts, W. G. Middlebrooks and L. A. Stubbs. To write Corresponding Letter: W. E. Green, L. A. Stubbs and M. F. Etheridge.

6th. Called for correspondence from the Flint River Corresponding Association and received F. E. Glover, Elder S. J. English, G. J. Windham, J. F. Daniels, H. Dixson. On motion adjourned to 9 o'clock a. m. to-morrow.

SATURDAY, SEPT. 15th, 10 o'CLOCK A. M.

The Association met pursuant to adjournment; prayer by the Moderator.

The clerk being absent in consequence of affliction in his family, Elder S. J. English was requested to act in his place.

1st. Called the roll.

2nd. Committee on business adopted the same order of last year.

3rd. Returned correspondence to the Flint River Corresponding Association to be held with Ebenezer church, Macon Co., Ga., beginning on Friday and embracing the 1st Sunday in Sept. 1901. W. G. Middlebrooks, W. R. Thames, A. L. Mathews, W. E. Green, A. R. Johnson, J. H. Colquitt, J. R. Roberts, L. A. Stubbs, M. J. Ray, E. C. Trice, J. L. Trailer, J. W. Herin, S. B. Busbay, B. F. King, W. L. Jordon. On motion, suspended the regular order of business and received Brethren E. Aultman, J. H. Jones, and A. J. Long, Correspondents from the Flint River Corresponding Union.

4th Resumed the regular order of business and appointed the mission meeting to be held with Mt. Olivet Church, Bibb Co., Ga., commencing on Friday before the 5th Sunday in March 1901.

5th Appointed next session of this body with Trinity church, Upson Co., Ga., beginning on Friday and embracing the 3rd Sunday in September, 1901.

6th. Called for and read Corresponding letter, and adopted same.

7th. Called for contributions from the churches, and received \$10.50 for minutes.

8th. Agreed to have 500 copies of this minute printed.

9th. Adjourned to time and place mentioned.
