## John R. Claypool, IV



John Claypool is a native of Franklin, Kentucky, but spent his childhood and youth years in Nashville, Tennessee. He is a graduate of Mars Hill College and Baylor University. He earned the Bachelor of Divinity and Doctor of Theology degrees from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Claypool was pastor of Crescent Hill Baptist Church, Louisville, Kentucky, from 1960 to 1971 and the Broadway Baptist Church, Fort Worth, Texas, from 1971 to 1976. He became pastor of Northminster Baptist Church, Jackson, Mississippi, in 1976.

Among many denominational positions, he was President of the Kentucky Baptist Convention, chairman and member of the SBC Christian Life Commission and member of the Board of Trustees of Texas Christian University.

Claypool has delivered the Hester Lectures at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, the Mullins Lectures at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, the Wells Sermons at Brite Divinity School of Texas Christian University, and the Lyman Beecher Lectures at Yale Divinity School.
