PARKING REMINDERS:

The Business Office reminds all students of the following concerning campus parking:
(1) Spaces in front of the Administration Building are reserved for faculty, administrative staff and guests. (2) Parking violations include: a. Parking in driveways, loading zones, or other areas marked "no parking," or parking so as to take up more than one space. b. Parking or driving on lawns or sidewalks. c. Obstructing movement of traffic. d. Having a decal which is not legible (warning will be given). e. Parking in spaces reserved for persons other than yourself. (3) The following fines will be in effect: a. Cars parked illegally - \$5.00. b. Fines not paid within one week will be charged to the individual's account. c. Visitors are not required to pay fines, but are expected to obey traffic signs.

RAPID READING CLASS:

Through cooperation with the Wake Technical Institute a class in Rapid Reading will be taught on the campus this semester. The class will meet on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 4:00 until 6:00 o'clock, beginning on Tuesday, September 27. The class does not carry any academic credit, but is designed to help the student improve reading speed and comprehension. There will be eleven periods of two hours each, and the cost to the student will be \$5.00. Wake Tech requires a minimum enrollment of fifteen students if the class is to be offered. If you are interested in taking the class please sign the sheet on the bulletin board in Appleby Hall. Signing the sheet does not commit the student absolutely, but if the class has to be closed to enrollment those on the sheet will be given preference.
