

Proceedings

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 13, 1928

1. After praise, and prayer by Elder W. C. Edwards, the introductory sermon was preached by Elder J. A. Fagg, Text: John 21:15-16.

2. After an intermission of one hour the messengers met in the church house where the association was opened with praise and prayer by Elder O. J. Denny.
