XEROX COPIER

SERVICE:

MONDAY LIBRARY SERVICE All persons who use the Library on Mondays from 3-4:00 p.m. are asked to expect two things: (1) basically self-service use of the Library and (2) possible disturbance from staff activities in some user work-areas. This hour is the one time during the week when all Student Assistants and full-time staff can be together for communication, training, and work on special projects.
